THE PURPOSE OF THIS WRITTEN AGREEMENT IS TO OUTLINE THE RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE SCHOOL, THE STUDENT, AND THE FAMILY.

1. The Alternate Program promises to provide challenging and worthwhile educational experiences for each student in the program.
2. The student promises to attend school regularly, complete all assignments and to be cooperative with all staff members.
3. Students will be expected to attend field trips. There are two types that the students will be attending this year. A few will be categorized as "reward" and most will "required" since they are an important part of the curriculum. **Please note that these trips are not optional.**
4. Parents/Guardians will review and discuss the progress reports with their youngster. It is understood that the home will reinforce the school's efforts to make sure their student's behavior, school work, and homework are acceptable. Progress reports will be sent home weekly.
5. It is the responsibility of the parents/guardians to call the Attendance Office at the Junior High School, ext. 4415 between 8:00 and 8:15 AM if your youngster is unable to attend school. As per Attendance Policy in the Student Handbook, documentation for absence must be submitted to the attendance office when the student returns to school.
6. Everyone is aware that work missed due to any absence must be made up. This may require the student to stay after regular school hours.
7. It is understood that a change in behavior and attitude will be necessary in order to improve school performance. This means setting goals and being receptive to new ideas and points of view. Talking to counselors, teachers and staff is a necessary and students will be expected to participate in this process.
8. The parent and student will be aware of the school rules and policies that are in the student handbook.
