

## Entrance into Alternate Program Criteria

1. 7<sup>th</sup> Grade Students who have failed 4 or more courses (pending they meet all other criteria).
2. 7<sup>th</sup> Grade Student who has failed 3 or More Core Courses may be considered (pending enrollment number in program).
3. Students in Non Credit Status may be considered pending current school year student enrollment in the program and teacher and guidance counselor recommendation.
4. Student must be non-classified or non- referred.  
**Special Note** – Classified students or students in the referral process may be considered for the program if included in the student’s IEP and placement in the alternate program is deemed appropriate by both the CST and the principal.
5. Teacher recommendations.
6. Guidance Counselor recommendations.
7. Supervisor of Alternate Program recommendation.
8. Principal retains final authority for entrance into the Alternate Program.
9. Enrollment is based on a 1:10 student teacher ratio or as authorized by the Principal.
10. Student has cooperated and accepted prior interventions, such as I &RS review recommendations, CST review recommendations, or Counseling Services.
