**Dear Parent:**

**Yearly, we receive money from the No Child Left Behind (NCLB) Federal grant program. Some of these funds are set aside to pay for after school supplemental educational services (tutoring) for struggling students on the Free and Reduced Lunch Program.**

**Because your child attends the Junior High School and is on the Free and Reduced Lunch Program, and may be struggling in mathematics or language arts (English), she/he is entitled to additional instructional help after school. This amounts to tutoring in small groups.**
